The Mercer County Track and Field Hall of Fame Committee will present the Larry Ivan Memorial Scholarship, in the amount of \$1,000, to one male student athlete. This award will be presented at the annual Hall of Fame induction ceremony which will be held at Mercer Oaks, 725 Village Rd W, West Windsor Township, NJ 08550, on Sunday, April 13, 2025. **Each head coach may nominate one senior male member of their team for consideration.**

*Larry served as a mentor and role model for the youth in his community for many years. He was a teacher and coach at Princeton Regional Schools from 1958-1999. In 2016, he received the Jim Floyd Lifetime Achievement Award for contributions to the Princeton Community. Larry was inducted into the Princeton High School Hall of Fame, the Princeton Recreation Department Hall of Fame, and the CYO Basketball Hall of Fame. Larry served as a CYO basketball official for 25 years with more than 1,000 games officiated. He was a Basketball Official for IAABO #193 for 51 years and served as both President and Vice President. of IAABO #193, He was a Track & Field official for 45 years and served as president for the Capital Track Officials Association. He was awarded the NJ Track & Field Association Jay Dakelman Lifetime Achievement Award, and the NJSAAA Outstanding Cross Country Official Award.*

The committee is looking for candidates who demonstrate the values that Larry Ivan possessed.

**In order to be considered, all applicants must meet the following criteria:**

- The applicant must be a current male senior enrolled in a Mercer County High School. The nominee must have earned a varsity letter in one or more of the following sports: Cross Country, Winter Track, or Spring Track.
- Each head coach may nominate one male member of their team for consideration.
- The head coach will fill out the attached form and submit it no later than **Friday, March 14, 2025.**
- The head coach may provide comments as to why their nominee is worthy of this award.
